

**Goal**

Fill in all the cells in the lines with the nine colored shapes - one shape per cell.

**Rules**

1. Place nine colored shapes into the cells in accordance with ALL the clues provided.
2. "To the left/right of" doesn't necessarily mean "adjacent".
3. The "neighbor" means adjacent.
4. The "chain" means occupying adjacent cells, following each other one by one.
5. The B, R and Y letters stand for Blue, Red and Yellow respectively.

1. There are no shapes to the left of the red circle.
2. There are no shapes to the right of the blue triangle.
3. There are exactly 4 shapes to the right of the yellow square.
4. There are exactly 2 shapes to the left of the yellow triangle and exactly 2 shapes to the right of the yellow circle.
5. The number of the cell occupied by a red triangle isn't higher than 3.
6. The number of the cell occupied by a blue circle isn't lower than 7.
7. The number of the cell occupied by a red square doesn't equal 6.
