

## BRYLine - Beginner 1

## Goal

Fill in all the cells in the lines with the nine colored shapes - one shape per cell.

## **Rules**

- 1. Place nine colored shapes into the cells in accordance with ALL the clues provided.
- 2. "To the left/right of" doesn't necessarily mean "adjacent".
- 3. The "neighbor" means adjacent.
- 4. The "chain" means occupying adjacent cells, following each other one by one.
- 5. The B, R and Y letters stand for Blue, Red and Yellow respectively.
  - 1. Triangles occupy the 4th, the 6th and the 9th cells.
  - 2. A square doesn't occupy any of the 1st, 7th or 8th cells.
  - 3. There is the R-R-R chain somewhere in the Line.
  - 4. The blue shapes occupy even cells only.
