

Goal

Fill in all the cells in the lines with the nine colored shapes - one shape per cell.

Rules

1. Place nine colored shapes into the cells in accordance with ALL the clues provided.
2. "To the left/right of" doesn't necessarily mean "adjacent".
3. The "neighbor" means adjacent.
4. The "chain" means occupying adjacent cells, following each other one by one.
5. The B, R and Y letters stand for Blue, Red and Yellow respectively.

1. Neither the first three cells nor the last three ones are painted in yellow.
2. The last three cells are not painted in red.
3. There is a double-circle chain to the left of a double-square chain.
4. A circle can not be the right neighbor of a square.
