

## BRYLine - Intermediate 1

## Goal

Fill in all the cells in the lines with the nine colored shapes - one shape per cell.

## **Rules**

- 1. Place nine colored shapes into the cells in accordance with ALL the clues provided.
- 2. "To the left/right of" doesn't necessarily mean "adjacent".
- 3. The "neighbor" means adjacent.
- 4. The "chain" means occupying adjacent cells, following each other one by one.
- 5. The B, R and Y letters stand for Blue, Red and Yellow respectively.
  - 1. Neither the first three cells nor the last three ones are painted in yellow.
  - 2. The last three cells are not painted in red.
  - 3. There is a double-circle chain to the left of a double-square chain.
  - 4. A circle can not be the right neighbor of a square.
